WALK INFORMATION Cameron Hiking Trail Head is a multi-use trail starting at a small parking area north of park headquarters. It travels above the water on a crushed gravel trail and interconnecting sections of road. The walk is 4 miles round-trip; about 2 miles out and 2 miles back. Extend your walk to include Wrinkle Cove Trail to Fiddlehead Boat Ramp. Stay hydrated! Bring a waterbottle to fill at the water station. Porta Potties are located at the beginning and end of Cameron Trail.

LUNCH Lunch will be cooked and served at the Jenny Lind Veterans Memorial Park in Valley Springs. Lunch will be prepared by Cynthia Przybyla, and Luiz and Patty Luna

SAFETY AND SECURITY First class radio support from the Calaveras Amateur Radio Society will monitor cyclists, and the American Legion Ambulance staffed with 2 emts will be standing by in the unlikely case of an emergency.
